Importance of sending sample discs to MediaWise:
All CD-COPS protected CD-ROMs that are produced out of the same glass-master are identical; therefore, the same access code could be used throughout that total production, for the protected application to run safely, under maximum security and compatibility. For that reason, the disc factory you are collaborating with, must press, or repress all the discs of your title, using the same glass-master, since this is the only way to ensure that all discs could use the same CD-COPS access code. In many cases of repressing, as well as big quantity pressing, where many stampers could be used, the disc factory might not follow this quality restriction. Then, new separate access codes should be calculated by measuring sample silver discs from each pressing, making sure that samples have been gathered from various different points, well-spread around within the total length of the production. MediaWise extensive tests shall verify the quality of the physical materials used for the CD production, as well as the quality of the proceedings followed. This way, MediaWise shall guaranty the total product quality and will be able to response quickly when technical assistance is required. At the same time, MediaWise shall be able to provide updated access codes that shall resolve more effectively any possible CD-ROM drive compatibility problems, reported up to that time.
